
Our Mission

Discounting of Black parents' and children's concerns regarding over and excessive discipline for misbehavior/minor infractions.




Districts/Schools' inability to create safe and supportive learning environments for Black children.



Our Solution--Microschools

BLACK MOTHERS FORUM MICROSCHOOLS

- 4 Locations (South Phoenix, Mesa, Northwest Phoenix)
- 11 Microschools. (Edkey/Sequoia Choice Distance Learning/Prenda)
- 43 students and each day we are adding more.
- Goal--58 Total Microschools (580 students) by end of 2021—2022 school year.
- It costs approximately \$10,000 to set up a microschool (rental fees, furniture, electronics, supplies, construction, etc.).
- Locations needed—community rooms, schools, churches, homes, etc.
