





BRIEF HISTORY


- DETENTION CENTER (PRIOR TO 2015):
 - \$800K TO \$1 MILLION TO OPERATE
 - AVERAGE DAILY POPULATION OF 1.7 JUVENILES
 - 6-8 WEEKS OF VACANCY
- DETENTION CENTER CLOSED JULY 2015
- JULY 2015 – MAY 2017:
 - \$90,000 PER YEAR (UP TO 4 JUVENILES PER DAY IN NAVAJO COUNTY FACILITY)
- GRAHAM, NAVAJO AND GILA COUNTIES CLOSE THEIR DETENTION CENTERS AS WELL

OBJECTIVES AFTER LEARNING TOUR

- INTAKE AND TEMPORARY HOLDING AREA
- 23 HOUR RESPITE, STABILIZATION, ASSESSMENT (AOC "ALTERNATIVE CENTERS")
- LEGACY TEEN CENTER – PROACTIVE ENGAGEMENT WITH TEENS
 - MUSIC, ART, VIDEO/AUDIO EDITING, TUTORING,
 - COMMUNITY COLLEGE ACCESS,
 - COORDINATING WITH LOCAL HIGH SCHOOLS (DANCES, TAIL GATE, CLUBS)
 - APACHE COUNTY YOUTH COUNCIL – INCENTIVES FOR SELF-PACED LEARNING




